is president of the National Association of Criminal Defense Lawyers. Ms. Orr was counsel on the amicus brief in *CNN v. General Manuel Noriega* before the United States Supreme Court, where she successfully defended this unpopular defendant’s attorney-client privilege, and obtained the first confession of error by the State of Texas in a death penalty case. She is a member of the American Bar Association’s Criminal Justice Council, a member of the Task Force rewriting the Standards for Prosecution and Defense Functions, and is listed in Woodward/White’s *Best Lawyers in America*.

STEPHEN B. KINNAIRD

is counsel for Petitioner in *Jose Padilla v. Commonwealth of Kentucky* (No. 08-651) before the United States Supreme Court, to be argued October 13, 2009. Mr. Kinnaird is a partner at Paul, Hastings, Janofsky & Walker LLP in Washington, D.C., a member of its Litigation Department and co-chair of the firm’s Appellate Practice section. He is a Lecturer in Law at the University of Pennsylvania Law School, co-teaches its Supreme Court Advocacy Clinic, and is a member of the Board of Directors of the Washington Lawyers’ Committee for Civil Rights. Prior to entering private practice, Mr. Kinnaird served as law clerk to Justice Anthony M. Kennedy of the United States Supreme Court.

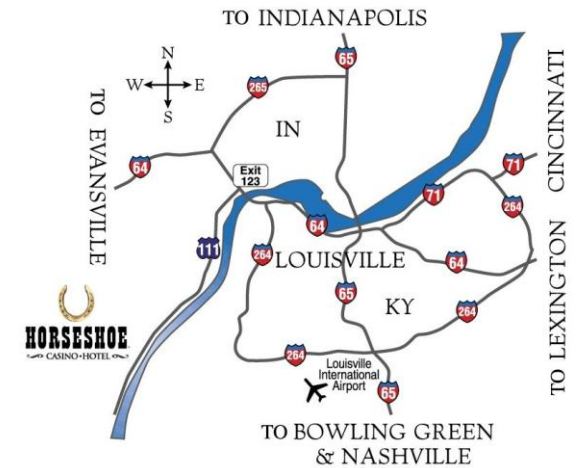
